What is Therapeutic Storywriting?

Therapeutic Storywriting uses the metaphor in stories to support children whose emotional and behavioural difficulties are getting in the way of their learning.

Evidence-based research shows that the 10-week intervention improves pupils' writing skills while also developing their emotional and social skills.

It is currently in use in over 500 schools in the UK and 60 schools across Hampshire.

By the end of this course you will be able to:

- Deliver the 10 week Therapeutic Storywriting intervention to groups of pupils.
- Write therapeutic stories to help address the emotional needs of pupils through metaphor.
- Evaluate and show evidence of the positive outcomes of the intervention.
